**Organization Overview:** Community Justice Alternatives of Durham Region was founded in 1981 as a non-profit agency partially funded by the Ontario Ministry of Children, Community & Social Services, Ministry of Community Safety and Correctional Services and is assisted by local Municipal grants, donations from local churches, community groups, individuals and businesses.

Our Mission is to function as a visible expression of concern for justice in the community by providing services to address the needs of those affected by conflict.

Our programs contribute toward the prevention of crime and the development of safer communities by addressing social issues and the rehabilitation of offenders. Our programs promote stronger communication and healthier well-being of family life.

We operate with a staff of 5 employees and 2 administrative volunteers, over 20 other volunteers and annually handle over hundreds of clients in the Durham Region. In addition to our ongoing programs we offer various services to the community. Ask about our Community Mediation and our Restorative Justice Training Services.

**Program Highlights:** CJA Durham is proud to have several long term and on-going programs that serve the people of Durham Region.

The Diverse Reintegration Youth Program was specifically designed to complement existing youth justice services by offering a reintegration program that offer culturally appropriate service to youth and their family in the Youth Criminal Justice System and funded by the Ministry of Children, Community & Social Services - <https://www.cjadurham.org/dryp>

Our CALM (Conflict, Anger Management, Learning Communication and Mediation) for youth is a one of a kind in the Region. One-on-One discussions with our Coordinator and Youth – why they did what they did and how they would do it differently next time! **Mediation:** Durham Community Mediation Program - <https://www.cjadurham.org/dcmp> and our Victim-Offender Reconciliation Program - <https://www.cjadurham.org/vorp> are highly regarded and staffed by qualified Volunteer Mediators.

**Mediation Skills Training:** Our Mediation Training is specific and skills based and we have offered our training programs off-site including several Indigenous Reserves across Ontario to assist them in setting up their own unique Restorative Justice Programs. <https://www.cjadurham.org/mediation-training-at-cjadurham>
